TERMS OF REFERENCE

Unicity Labs Family Medicine Travel Award

Unicity Labs has established an endowment fund at the University of Manitoba with an initial gift of \$25,000. Unicity Labs is a full service community clinical laboratory that provides services to physician clinics in Winnipeg. It has provided services for more than 30 years and is locally owned by four partners.

The purpose of the fund will be to provide financial support to a first or second year family medicine resident to attend a national meeting or conference (e.g., CCME or FMF). Unicity Labs has offered to contribute an extra \$2,500 so that one award valued at \$2,150 may be offered in each of the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years. As of the 2022 -2023 academic year the available earnings from the fund will be used to offer one travel award to a student who:

- (1) is enrolled full-time in the first or second year of study in the Postgraduate Medical Education Program (PGME), in the Max Rady College of Medicine in the Department of Family Medicine;
- (2) is traveling to a conference, seminar, or other approved event that is associated with their program.

Selection of candidates will be based on preceptor's annual evaluations of residents.

The selection committee for this award will be named by the Dean of the Max Rady College of Medicine (or designate).

The Board of Governors of the University of Manitoba has the right to modify the terms of this award if, because of changed conditions, it becomes necessary to do so. Such modification shall conform as closely as possible to the expressed intention of the donor in establishing the award.
