

The Manitoba & National Chapter Guidelines for the Awards of Excellence

The CFPC wishes to empower the Chapters to recognize their members, and in turn, the CFPC's members who have made an outstanding contribution in the past 12 to 24 months to the discipline of family medicine.

DEADLINES:

The deadline for members to submit their nominations for the Awards of Excellence to the Manitoba College of Family Physicians office is January 30, 2023.

REQUIREMENTS:

The awards were created as a way for both the Provincial and National Colleges to recognize family physicians who are worthy and recognized through nomination at the Provincial Chapter level. The Awards of Excellence recognizes members who, in the past 12 to 24 months, have made outstanding contributions to one or more of the following:

- patient care;
- community service;
- hospital or health care institutions;
- College activities (National and Chapter); and
- teaching, research, or other elements of the discipline of family medicine

ELIGIBILITY:

- nominee must be a member in good standing;
- nominations can be from members or the public;
- physician practice groups and family medicine residents are eligible;
- the runners-up to Family Physician of the Year can be considered;
- members can be re-nominated in subsequent years for new outstanding achievements;
- the CFPC will acknowledge provincial recipients at the Family Medicine Forum, on the website and publish the names in the national Family Medicine journal (Canadian Family Physician); and
- up to 50 Canadian Awards of Excellence can be supported by national per year with a maximum from each Chapter based on the above chart.

RECOGNITION:

The MCFP will recognize the recipient at their AMM, at the ASA, at the MCFP Celebration of Family Medicine, and other provincial events in Manitoba, as well as through the member newsletter, social media, and the website.

The winners of the Manitoba Awards of Excellence are awarded a free seat at the Celebration of Family Medicine & the ASA. All awards are taxable income.

Note: All awards over \$499 are taxable income, as per the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA).
